John 3:16 – Who Are God's Children?

**Hebrews 2:** <sup>8</sup>putting everything in subjection under his feet." Now in putting everything in subjection to him, he left nothing outside his control. At present, **WE** do not yet see everything in subjection to him. <sup>9</sup>But **WE** see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, **crowned with glory and honor** because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death **for everyone**.

**Romans 2:** <sup>7</sup>**to those** who by patience in **well-doing seek** for **glory and honor and immortality** (*imperishability*), **he will give ETERNAL LIFE**; (*age-lasting life*)

<sup>8</sup>**BUT for those** who are **self-seeking** and **do not obey the truth**, but obey unrighteousness, **there will be wrath and fury**. <sup>9</sup>There will be tribulation and distress for **every human being** who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek,

**John 17:** <sup>6</sup> "I have manifested your name **to the people whom you gave me** **OUT of the world**. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and **they have kept your word**.

<sup>7</sup>Now **they know** that everything that you have given me is from you. <sup>8</sup>For I have given **them the words** that you gave me, and **they have received them** and have come to **know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me**.

<sup>9</sup>I am praying for them. **I am NOT praying for the world** **BUT for those whom you have given me, for they are yours**. <sup>10</sup> All mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them.

<sup>11</sup>And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be **one**, even as we are **one**. <sup>12</sup> While I was with them, I kept them in your name, which you have given me. I have guarded them, and not one of them has **been lost** except the son of

destruction, that the Scripture might be fulfilled. <sup>13</sup>But now I am coming to you, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

<sup>14</sup> I have given them **your word**, and **the world has hated them** because **they are not of the world**, just as **I am not of the world**.

<sup>15</sup>I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one.

<sup>16</sup> They are **NOT of the world**, just as I am **NOT of the world**. <sup>17</sup> Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.

**2 Corinthians 4:** <sup>4</sup>In their case (*their - who? Those in verse 3 who are perishing-it's talking here about the redeemed*) **the god of this world** has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

**John 17:** <sup>18</sup> As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. <sup>19</sup>And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth.

**Hebrews 2:** <sup>16</sup>For surely it is not angels that he helps, **but he helps the offspring of Abraham**. <sup>17</sup>Therefore he had to be made like **his brothers** in every respect, **SO THAT** he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, **to make propitiation for the sins of the people**. <sup>18</sup>For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

**Galatians 3:** <sup>28</sup> There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one **IN** Christ Jesus. <sup>29</sup>And **IF** you are Christ's, **THEN** you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.

**Galatians 5:** <sup>24</sup>And **those who belong to Christ** Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

<sup>16</sup>But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. <sup>17</sup>For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.

<sup>18</sup>But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. <sup>19</sup>Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, <sup>20</sup>idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, <sup>21</sup>envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, **that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.** <sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup>gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

**Hebrews 2:** <sup>17</sup>Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, **SO THAT** he might become a **merciful and faithful high** priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. <sup>18</sup>For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

**Galatians 3:** <sup>28</sup> There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one **IN** Christ Jesus. <sup>29</sup>And **IF** you are Christ's, **THEN you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.** (*the promise is the inheritance in the future kingdom*)

**John 8:** <sup>36</sup>So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. <sup>37</sup>I know that you are offspring of Abraham; **YET** you seek to kill me because my word finds no place in you. <sup>38</sup> I speak of what I have seen with my Father, and **you do** what you have heard from your father."

<sup>39</sup>They answered him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would **BE DOING the works** Abraham **DID**, <sup>40</sup>but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham **DID**. <sup>41</sup>You are **doing the works** your father **DID**." They said to him, "We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one Father—even God." <sup>42</sup>Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here. I came not of my own accord, but he sent me. <sup>43</sup> Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you cannot bear to hear my word. <sup>44</sup> You are of your father the devil, and your will **is to do** your father's desires. He

was a murderer from the beginning, and has nothing to do with the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. <sup>45</sup>But because I tell the truth, you do not believe me. <sup>46</sup>Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me? <sup>47</sup> Whoever is of God hears the words of God. The reason why you do not hear them is that you are not of God."

**John 3:** <sup>10</sup>Jesus answered him, "Are you the teacher of Israel and yet you do not understand these things?

<sup>16</sup>"For God so loved **the world**, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. <sup>17</sup>For God did not send his Son into **the world** to condemn **the world**, but in order that **the world** might be saved through him.

<sup>18</sup> Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. <sup>19</sup> And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. <sup>20</sup> For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. <sup>21</sup>But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God." <sup>22</sup>After this Jesus and his disciples went into the Judean countryside, and he remained there with them and was baptizing.

**John 1:** <sup>10</sup>He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. <sup>11</sup>He came to that which was **his own** (*Israel*) , **but his own** (*Israel*) did not receive him.

<sup>29</sup>The next day John (*the Baptist*) saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away (*not an event-it's an on going process-present active participle- refers to an action that is currently taking place or which takes place repeatedly*) the sin of the world!

**Matthew 10:** <sup>5</sup>These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: "**Do not go among the Gentiles** (*the rest of the world*) or enter any town of the Samaritans.

**Go rather to the lost sheep of Israel.** <sup>7</sup>As you go, preach this message: 'The kingdom of heaven is near.'

**John 18:** <sup>19</sup>Meanwhile, the high priest questioned Jesus about his disciples and his teaching. <sup>20</sup>"**I have spoken openly to the world,**" Jesus replied. "**I ALWAYS taught in synagogues or at the temple, where all the JEWS come together.** I said nothing in secret.

**John 12:** <sup>17</sup>Now the crowd that was with him when he called Lazarus from the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to spread the word. <sup>18</sup>**Many people**, because they had heard that he had given this miraculous sign, **went out to meet him.**

<sup>19</sup>So the Pharisees said to one another, "See, this is getting us nowhere. **Look how the whole world** (*THE "many people" of v:18-Israel*) has gone after him!"

**John 17:** <sup>14</sup>I have given them your word **and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world.** <sup>15</sup>My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. <sup>16</sup>**They are not of the world, even as I am not of it.**

**1 John 2:** <sup>15</sup>**Do not love the world or anything in the world.** If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <sup>16</sup>For everything in the world—the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does—comes not from the Father but from the world. <sup>17</sup>The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever.

**Daniel 9:** <sup>4</sup>I prayed to the LORD my God **and made confession**, saying, "O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps covenant and steadfast love **with those who love him** and **keep his commandments**,
