The Abhorrence and Horror of False Prophets!

2 Timothy 2: ³This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, ⁴who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. ⁵For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

Matthew 7:¹³ **"ENTER BY THE NARROW GATE.** For the gate is **WIDE** and **the way is EASY** that leads to **DESTRUCTION**, and those who enter by it **are MANY**. ¹⁴For the gate is **NARROW** and **the way is HARD** that leads to **LIFE**, and **those who find it are FEW**.

¹⁵ **"BEWARE OF FALSE PROPHETS**, *(specializes in "the art of misimpression,"- when in fact, they operate by self and for self)* who come **TO YOU** *(those who are endeavoring to enter the narrow gate into the kingdom)* in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves.

¹⁶**You will** *(future-middle-indicative)* recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles?

¹⁷So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. ¹⁸A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. ¹⁹ Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰Thus you will recognize them by their fruits. ²¹ "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' **will enter the kingdom of heaven, BUT the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.**

²² **ON THAT DAY MANY** will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' ²³ And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'

1 Corinthians 3: ¹³ **each one's work WILL** become manifest, **for THE Day will disclose it**, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of **work each one has done**. ¹⁴If the work that **anyone** has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵If **anyone's** work is burned up, **he will suffer loss**, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.

²⁶So when the plants came up and bore grain, **then** the weeds appeared also.

²⁷And the servants of the master of the house came and said to him, 'Master, did you not sow **good seed** (*the word of the kingdom*) in **YOUR** field? How then does it have weeds?'

²⁸He said to them, '**An enemy has done this.**'

.....So the servants said to him, 'Then do you want us to go **and gather them?**'

²⁹But he said, '**No**, lest in gathering the weeds you root up **the wheat along with them.**

³⁰**Let both grow together UNTIL the harvest, AND AT HARVEST TIME** (*the day of the resurrection*) **I will tell** the reapers, Gather the weeds first and bind them in bundles to be burned, but gather the wheat into my barn.'"

Matthew 7:¹⁷So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit.

¹⁸A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. ¹⁹ Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

Do you see the same outcome here as in Chapter 13?

²⁰Thus **YOU WILL** (*future-middle-indicative*) recognize them by their fruits.

²¹ "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' **will enter the kingdom of heaven,** **BUT the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.**

²² **On that day many** will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, **DID WE** not prophesy **IN YOUR NAME,** and cast out demons **IN YOUR NAME,** and do many mighty works **IN YOUR NAME?**'

²³ And then **will I declare TO THEM**, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.' *Anomia-the condition of without law-contempt and violation of law, iniquity, wickedness*

²⁴ "Everyone then **who hears** these words of mine **and does them** will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock. ²⁶And **everyone who hears these words of mine and does not do them** will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand.

²⁷And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell, and great was the fall of it."
