Acts 2

Universal - All Nations - The New Covenant

Hebrews 8:6-8: But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, by as much as He is also the mediator of a better covenant, which has been enacted on better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no occasion sought for a second. For finding fault with them, He says, "BEHOLD, DAYS ARE COMING, SAYS THE LORD, WHEN I WILL EFFECT A NEW COVENANT WITH THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL AND WITH THE HOUSE OF JUDAH"

Galatians 3:8-9: The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, **preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "ALL THE NATIONS WILL BE BLESSED IN YOU."** So then those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer.

Ephesians 3:6: to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel

The Purpose and Goal of our Redemption



LORD's Oath to David - A throne forever - 2 Samuel 7:1-17

Psalms 89:3-4: I have made a covenant with My chosen; I have sworn to David My servant, I will establish your seed forever and build up your throne to all generations.

LORD's Oath to Abraham - A people forever - Genesis 12:1-3

Genesis 22:16-18: By Myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this thing and have not withheld your son, your only son, indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies. In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.

The Basics: The Gospel The LORD'S Three Oaths

Matthew 1:1: The record of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham

Galatians 3:16-18: Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as referring to many, but rather to one, "And to your seed," that is, Christ. What I am saying is this: the Law, which came four hundred and thirty years later, does not invalidate a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to nullify the promise. For if the inheritance is based on law, it is no longer based on a promise; but God has granted it to Abraham by means of a promise.
